The Mayor's Parlour overlooks the front of the park and is an ideal choice for smaller weddings of up to 36 people.

The two Council Chambers can be used separately or together and can accommodate up to 70 people. There is a veranda to the side of the Chambers which overlooks the historic orangery.

You are welcome to have a drinks reception after the ceremony as part of the package.

The Orangerie & Park

Within Bitton Park is an historic orangerie managed by the Friends of Teignmouth Orangerie. For a donation the volunteers will open the orangerie which is a beautiful setting for photographs.

Another spot for photographs is in front of the two cannons from the 1816 siege of Algiers which are positioned at the front of the house.
