Young people – approach youth groups, schools.

Consider improved use of Social Media – thinking about how to reach out to young people.

Community Connector just recently employed whose role will be able help with the young people and reaching out to them.
Improve message about what the NHP is, what it can do for Teignmouth.

4 Results Questionnaire

No major surprises.

Renewables supported (questionnaire results). To be explored further later down the line.

Media – must inform local media. Importance to feedback and let people know that the process is ongoing.

USP – the plan can also be used to highlight aspirational projects for which funding could be drawn down.
