Following last Friday's edition of the Teignmouth Post, it has become evident that the Independent Investigation into Cllr Burgess has been completed.

Reply

As per the Council's decision on the 17th July 2018 the full report was not released as there are references to third parties for which Teignmouth Town Council believes are exempt under section 40 (personal information) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), as the information constitutes third party data. Section 40(2) provides that personal data about third parties is exempt information if one of the conditions set out in section 40(3) is satisfied.

Therefore, under the FOI Act disclosure of this information would breach the fair processing principle contained in the Data Protection Act (DPA), where it would be unfair to that person/is confidential.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to: Town Clerk, Teignmouth Town Council, Bitton House, Bitton Park Road, Teignmouth, TQ14 9DF
