

## **POP-UP /HEAT CAFES IN TEIGNMOUTH**

A number of other venues have now come on line as well as other people keen to publicise what's available so we attach below the current list of places that we know of offering a safe, warm place and, often, some free food and a hot drink and company – the Teignmouth Post published an extended list for the whole area on 26 January 2023 but times for Teignmouth, here, have been doubled checked and updated where necessary:

**Mondays and Thursdays 1:30-4:00pm**  
**The Alice Cross Centre, Bitton Park Road**

Food and hot drinks, free or pay what you can.

**Mondays 1:00–3:00 pm and Thursdays 10:00-12 noon**  
**Kingsway Meadow Centre Cosy Club**

Free drinks and snacks and activities such as jigsaws, board games.

**Tuesdays 2.00-5.00pm**  
**St James Church, Bitton Park Road**

Offering a free drink and a snack to all ages in the Church

**Wednesdays 12:30-2:00pm**  
**Teignmouth Baptist Church, Fore Street**

Free bowl of hot soup and a roll

**Wednesday and Friday 10:00–12 noon**  
**Teignmouth Library**

Warm, welcoming and here for life, a designated warm site. Free hot drinks. Also there is a Warm Coat (hat, scarf, gloves) Rack in the foyer where people can donate warm coats and other clean item(s) that may help someone else out and where those who need one can take one, for free. Check first if you have something to drop off, as they were oversubscribed with donations (which is great).
